### *2013 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon*

#### VINEYARD NOTES

##### *Growing Season*

The 2013 season began with a warm, dry spring, bringing an early bud break, with consistently ideal temperatures through summer, offering optimal vine activity and beautiful ripening. With many harvests beginning as early as August 1<sup>st</sup>, the Cabernet Sauvignon remaining through fall had ample time and space to dry out and linger longer on the vine, developing more phenolic and flavor maturities while sugar levels remained steady. Through precise blending, The 2013 Eagle Glen Cabernet Sauvignon reflects the measured growth of a temperate summer yielding grapes of perfect ripeness.

##### *Location*

The 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon represents a blend of carefully-selected lots within multiple Napa Valley vineyards. The Cabernet fruit was harvested from three different vineyards in St. Helena, Oakville and Calistoga. The grapes for the 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon were picked at an average of 25.8° Brix and hand-sorted before a cold soak and stainless steel fermentation.

#### TASTING NOTES

A classic Napa Valley Cabernet, the 2013 Eagle Glen Cabernet Sauvignon boasts black cherry and cassis aromas, with distinct floral and dark fruits slowly rising from the glass. Pouring a deep burgundy color, the flavors on the palate echo these aromas, accented masculine, silky tannins and with hints of red cherry. Notes of savory spices and dark chocolate play a supporting role as the wine's initial flavors move across the palate and linger with remarkable length and complex finish.
